We'd like *YOUR* help with a research study on how children learn to hear their mother tongue!

This is how the study works: Your child will play some word and sound games with an experimenter at a laptop. First they will name familiar objects or repeat their names. Later, they will listen to two aliens who are learning English, and judge how well they produce similar and different words, in English and the alien language. They will also play a game in which they repeat nonsense words. We'll ask you to fill out a brief questionnaire about how your child has learned and is still learning words and language. Your child will receive a hearing screening.

This experiment takes *less than an hour*. You can either VISIT us at **SFU's Burnaby campus**, scheduled at your convenience, OR we can visit you at **your home**.
