What is Richmond Family Place?

Richmond Family Place is a Family Resource Program that offers drop in programs for families with children aged 0-6 years old and siblings up to 12 years old. Through our programs and services, we work to empower and strengthen children and families through innovative prevention and support programs. Our mission is to 'Ensure Every Child in Richmond Reaches their Full Potential.'

Family Support Workers

Our Family Support Workers support and guide caregivers and children as they grow together. They are here to help you navigate your parenting questions, direct you to resources in the Richmond community, foster connections between families, and much more. We are always happy to meet with new or returning families and help answer questions.

Memberships

Richmond Family Place is a membership-based organization. Our membership costs \$25 per year per family and runs from April to April. A family's financial position is never a barrier to our programs and services, so a pay-what-you-can option is available for families who have spoken with a Family Support Worker. All families are required to become members so we can continue to offer low-cost or free programs, pay for our building costs, and provide high quality materials for our programs.

Program Activities

Our Mainsite has indoor and outdoor spaces for families to play, learn, and explore. Our programs offer outdoor activities that occur rain or shine, so please ensure you are prepared for the weather conditions; bring appropriate items such as hats, jackets, umbrellas, sunscreen, etc. There may also be art activities or 'messy play,' so families are welcome to bring extra clothes.

Parents must stay with their children at all times.

What to Know Before Joining Our Programs

MAINSITE:

- **Please enter through the side gate of the building.** There is a doorbell located outside the fence. Ring **BOTH** bells and a staff will come and assist you with sign-in.
- When the program is full, a **STOP** sign will be posted outside the garden gate and in front of the main doors to let families know.
- We have a no-shoe policy for our Mainsite indoor spaces. Families are welcome to remove their shoes or bring their own indoor shoes to use.
- **Meal Times:** *During meal times, the playrooms will be closed so we can enjoy a meal together*

- **If it is your first time joining us:** please let a staff member know so that we can give you a tour of the space and let you know what to expect.
