Program Information

A child care funding is available to help families in B.C. with the cost of child care:

- Families that earn up to \$111,000 may qualify for funding
- Families may be able to apply for full or partial funding depending on their circumstances and income

Community Care Facilities Licensing

Protects and promotes the health, safety and well-being of children in licensed child care centres. This is done through education, collaboration and regulation.

Program Information

Community Care Facilities Licensing provides:

- information to the public
- consultation and resources
- inspection and assessment of potential facilities and sites
- assessment of licensee or manager to determine eligibility
- assessment of qualifications and suitability
- inspections
- assessment and support of licensed facility
- investigation of serious incidents, abuse, complaints and contraventions to the Community Care and Assisted Living Act and Regulations
- investigation of facilities operating without a Community Care Facility License.
